AIA PHILIPPINES PARTNERS WITH THE PCP FOUNDATION TO EMPOWER MORE FILIPINOS TO LIVE HEALTHIER, LONGER, BETTER LIVES

MANILA, PHILIPPINES – Since it was established in 1947, the country's premier life insurance company, AIA Philippines (formerly AIA Philam Life), has been actively partnering with various organizations to empower more Filipinos to live healthier, longer, and better lives.

As a testament to its commitment, the company is inking more partnerships to support initiatives that push its advocacies promoting health and wellness. AIA Philippines' most recent collaboration is with the Physicians Foundation, Inc. (PCPF) who received a donation pledge of PHP1.5 million to fund the organization's Bridging Leadership Workshops and projects, and other non-communicable disease registry/programs.

The <u>Philippine College of Physicians (PCP)</u> is the umbrella organization of internists in the Philippines. This organization aims to continue the medical education of internists and other physicians, and provide accreditation and certification of training programs for internal medicine in the Philippines. PCP created the PCP Foundation to become the social service arm of the College.

The PCP conducted a Bridging Leadership Workshop in 2021 for their members. This is a transformational leadership program focused on enabling the physicians to work with other stakeholders, such as the local government units, in providing innovative health projects for their respective communities. AIA Philippines is supporting some of the projects.

Some notable programs under the partnership include GINAHA (the Sweetheart Project, which aims to improve health outcomes through community empowerment of indigent hypertensive and diabetic patients of barangay San Isidro village, Virac, Catanduanes. Another is the "Magpangaman gamit ang BOTA, Leptospirosis matana ta" initiated by the PCP Western Visayas-Panay chapter that aims to prevent Leptospirosis among farmers from Cabatuan, Iloilo, a town where a high incidence of Leptospirosis is found. If these programs are successful, it can serve as a model for preventing non-communicable diseases and leptospirosis in other areas.

"We at AIA Philippines are well-positioned to make a difference in health and wellness by supporting initiatives that can contribute towards improvements in the health care sector," Kelvin Ang, CEO of AIA Philippines, said. "We are proud to partner with the PCP Foundation and other organizations in the health sector. Supporting their initiatives go a long way towards helping more Filipinos live Healthier, Longer, Better Lives."

About PCP

The PCP is the umbrella organization of internists in the Philippines and was organized in 1953. The 3 main reasons for its existence are:

- 1. Continuing Medical Education of internists and other physicians;
- 2. Certification and Regulation of the Subspecialty of Internal Medicine;
- Accreditation and Certification of the Training Programs for Internal Medicine in the Philippines.

Dr. Gonzalo F. Austria is the Founding President of the PCP.

The PCP is an affiliate society of the Philippine Medical Association and a member-society of the International Society of Internal Medicine. The College has a total of 9,111 members composed of Fellows, Diplomates and Members. The title of Diplomate in Internal Medicine is awarded by the PCP to an internist who has fulfilled all the requirements set by the Philippine Specialty Board of Internal Medicine which administers the certifying examinations annually. The title of Fellow is awarded to a Diplomate in Internal Medicine who has fulfilled the requirements for membership as Fellow in the PCP. Thus, an internist who has satisfactorily passed and fulfilled the requirements of the PCP and having been certified as such, may carry the title Diplomate in Internal Medicine and Fellow of the PCP (FPCP).

The College has 16 component and affiliate societies under it. It also has 22 regional chapters nationwide and 8 chapters on NCR.
